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Minutes of the Last Meeting

October 7, 2021

The regular meeting started at 7:00. At the prior Board Meeting it was Josh, Harry, Ray, and I. Not much to go over. When Josh opened the forum, we were quickly joined by Don, Dwight, Seth, and Carl. I don't think I missed anyone.

Treasury Report: The bank balance as reported last month stands at \$4,505.83. Clark has not submitted expenses for a few months.

Membership: No new members were reported. Total membership stands at about 60!

Old Business: At the last meeting it was suggested that we try to setup an in-person Get Together at Sterling Restorations. Josh was able to get this setup in short order and it went off without a hitch. See complete report on page 5.

New Business: We will be trying to setup in-person meetings each month as there is a lot of interest. From the Survey Josh reported that most people preferred Saturday or Sunday (about equal) over weekday dates. Watch for announcements in the Spyder Web or via email.

Events: Ray got back from his work/vacation in Main. While there he went to the Owls Head Transportation Museum in Owls Head, Maine. They have a great collection of cars, motorcycles, planes, bicycles, you-name-it. This was fabulous! Back home, Ray went to the 34th Annual All Italian Day Car & Motorcycle Show in Alameda. Lots of Alpha-Romeos, not too many motorcycles. But lots of amazing cars. There was a very nice Maserati Bora (mid-engine, 4-wheel independent suspension). This was the same day as our Get Together so he couldn't attend both! As a "thank you" for hosting the Get Together Josh gave Gabe a Club t-shirt and decals.

Tech: Ray is planning on rebuilding his Carter YH carburetor on his Turbo. Hopefully this will cure the high-speed issues he was having.

Josh said his heads were still in the shop getting repaired. In the mean time he will swap engines from his '65 140 and the '64 110. Hopefully this coming weekend baring any other issues that might arise. The 110 engine needs some work. He thinks he might have an oil blockage somewhere that was causing his issues. Josh picked up some adjustable struts. The struts cost \$389 per set. A lot, but the quality justifies the price. Seth said



he can now replace the eccentric washer and substitute a plane one. Now a loose bolt won't effect camber. Then just use the struts for camber adjustment. Maybe a visit to Don's to borrow his alignment tools when the time comes.

Carl said he has installed new stainless steel brake lines but was having trouble getting them to seal (remember Jeff's issue last month?). Especially the rear brakes. He expects to just replace them (again) this time using mild steel lines and be done with it. Josh was able to send Carl another brake junction block that he was asking for last month. Unfortunately, the fittings were the wrong size, but Carl was able to locate a suitable replacement, so he is all set to go. He also plans to make a video-tour of his garage, but this must wait until the Covid lock-down ends. He asked what A/T fluid to use? Seth said he could use most any A/T fluid, no need

for synthetic. If he had a manual transmission he would need GL 4 for the differential. Carl comments on the Roger Parent throttle linkage he installed on his 110 motor. Went on very easy and works great. Seth mentioned that if he had had a 140, the adjustment would have been quite tricky. Carl said he had lots of oil that that has been sitting unopened for years. Is it still good? Seth said to shake it up in case the additives have settled out but it would still be good.

Dwight said that a friend's father had passed away who worked at a local Chevy dealership. He had lots of material saved. Dwight was given some new, 1960 Corvair brochures (great keepsake!) along with



some new pistons and jugs.

Swap & Sell: Nothing new was reported.

Meeting adjourned about 8:47.

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



